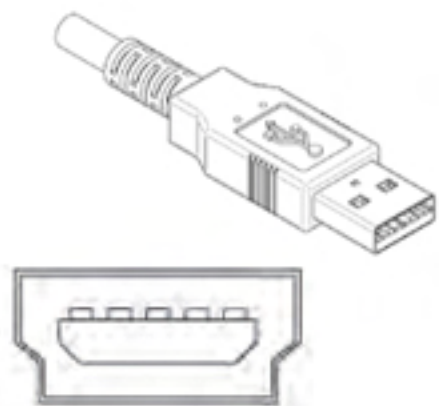
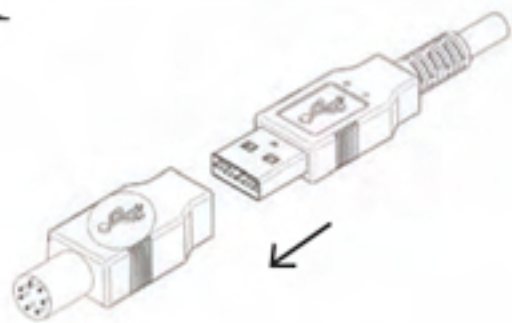

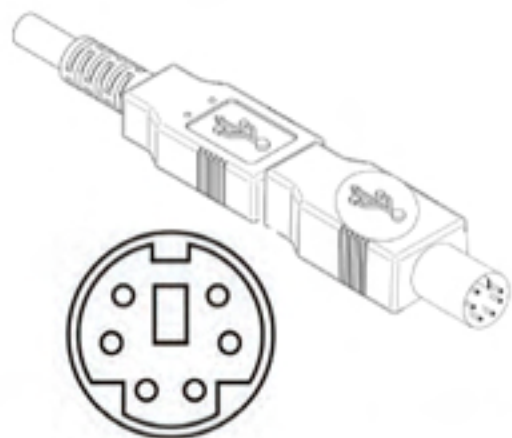

Before you begin
